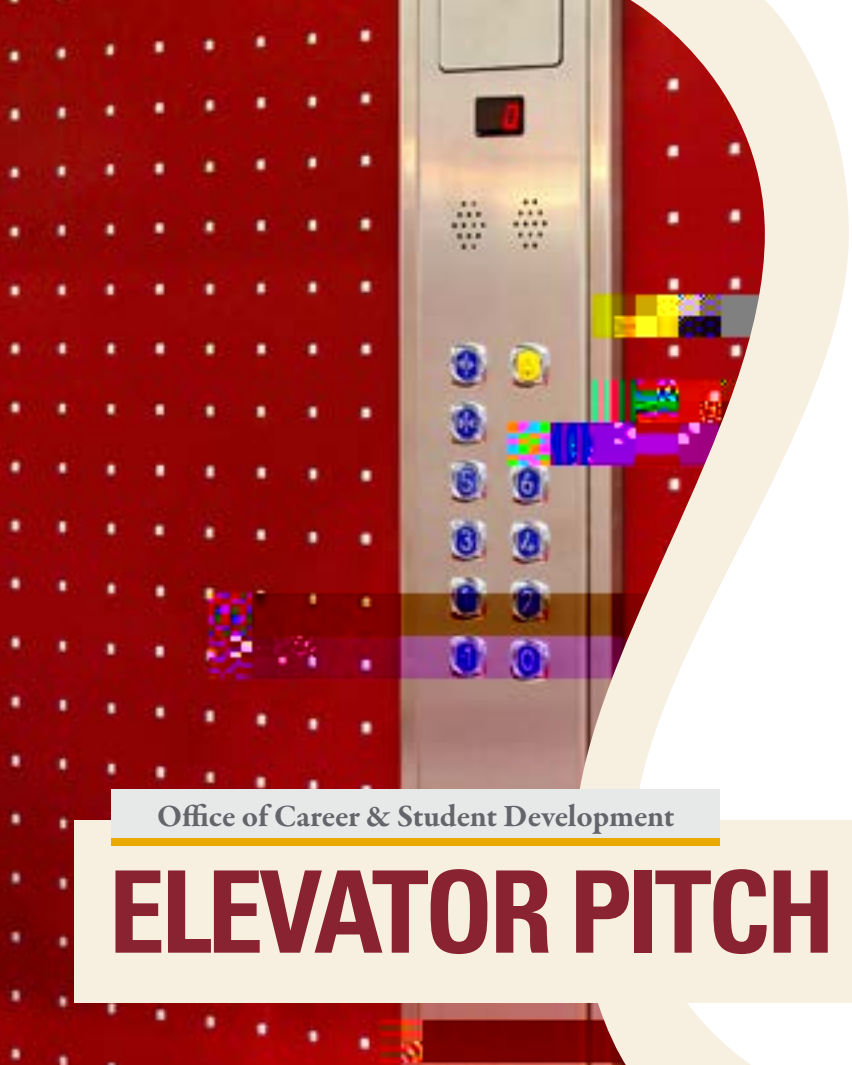
Dear Students,
